Program Description

The *Two-Year Apprenticeship Program in Shamanism and Shamanic Healing* is an experiential program designed to provide a strong base of knowledge and experience in shamanic practice. You will learn a wide array of effective and ethical tools and techniques you can use in your own work or on behalf of others and our planet. You will find your unique pathway for deep connection with your personal spirit helpers and the unseen world beyond. It is taught in the Core Shamanic Tradition blended with my personal experience and outlook developed over many years of focused shamanic practice.

The goals of the program are:

- To provide you with a rich and varied toolkit of shamanic practices and approaches to working with others
- To take you as deep as you can go in your spiritual connection over the 2-year period
- To maintain a light, humble, and respectful community as we do this challenging work

Some of the topics we will explore are:

- Nuances and power of the shamanic journey
- The spiritual aspect of healing physical conditions and bringing spirit into “mind-body-spirit” healing and wholeness
- Soul retrieval, soul loss, trauma, and life purpose
- Transgenerational and societal healing
- Healing with nature and place
- Working with community, ceremony, and spiritual activism

Shamanism is a unique and powerful way of healing. It is not a path of medical intuition, psychotherapy, body work, or energy medicine. Shamanism is soul work. It is a practice of deep healing for illness and disharmony in the mind-body-spirit wholeness that we are.

Our work will rely on rhythm and drumming to carry us to the unseen world, as is the practice of the vast majority of shamanic cultures around the world and throughout time.

Additional Information

Session Schedule and Tuition

The group will meet for a total of 8 weekends, usually from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm on Saturday and Sunday. Between sessions there will be some “homework” and suggestions for practice on your own or with others. A certificate of completion will be given at the end of the program.

The first session is scheduled for November 16 & 17, 2019. Subsequent sessions will be scheduled as a group, with the intention of meeting quarterly, to ensure a time when all can attend. The group will be limited to 10 participants.

Program tuition is \$2,000. A deposit of \$250 is required to reserve your place. The deposit will be applied to your program tuition and is refundable until November 1, 2019. The remaining balance of \$1,750 is due November 16, 2019, or you may opt for a quarterly payment schedule beginning in February 2020. Please contact me if you need other payment options or help with tuition.

Program Requirements

Admission to the program is by application. Prerequisite is the *Journey into Shamanism* weekend workshop or permission from me based on your readiness for the work. The Two-Year Apprenticeship is a comprehensive program in progressively more advanced shamanic practices. For this reason, participants are expected to attend every session, except in case of emergency.
